

# Rules of procedure for the contest “The Arab of the Future”

## **Contest**

Asameena is organizing a contest called The Arab of the Future.

## **Categories**

The contest is divided in four categories:

- Prose (fiction, essay)
- Poetry (including slam)
- Audio-visual Artworks (short-movies, montages, videos)
- Visual Artworks (drawing, photography, painting, caricature, collage etc.)

## **Participants**

Can take part in the contest anyone above the age of 18 and below the age of 30, regardless of their country of residency.

## **Methods for participation**

There are no entry fees for this contest.

Participants must submit their artworks through the submission platform on the Asameena website or found here:

Participants submitting video artwork can submit it through platforms such as Youtube or Vimeo to the email: **asameenamag@gmail.com**

Only completed applications will be considered.

Each participant is only allowed to submit one original work. If a participant is submitting work as part of a group he will also be able to submit an individual original piece.

Participants must certify that their work is original and has not been published anywhere else. Any violation of these terms will result in elimination from the contest.

Deadline for submissions is April 20th.

## **Selection process**

The editorial committee of the magazine will perform a first selection. Only finalists will be notified.

A jury of artists, performers, and writers will choose the winners for each category in June. The decision is final.

## **Prizes**

This contest awards four prizes, one for each category. The prize is the sum of 400 euros.

Participants who have not won but whose work has been noticed by the Asameena team will have the possibility to publish their work on the Arab of the Future issue of Asameena.

## **Responsibilities**

Participation to the contest leads to the acceptance of the hereby rules of procedure, including the eventual modifications that could be necessary in the future. Participants will be informed of the modifications.

In no case, can the organizers be held responsible of accidents, damages, costs, whether direct or indirect that could occur in the participation to the contest.

Should the contest be cancelled, interrupted or postponed, for reasons beyond the control of the organizers, they would hold no responsibility whatsoever.

## **Data**

The data collected through the submission process will not be used for any other purpose.
